

Rules for BSc and BA degrees with the purpose of increasing consistency and uniformity among the RU Schools

Students must complete 42-48 ECTS before they start 2 nd year study.	Students must complete 90-96 ECTS and have finished all required 1 st year courses before they start 3 rd year study. Maximum one year in all programs.	<p>Courses taken by student more than 9 years ago prior to being registered at RU will not be transferred.. The grade must be 6 (on the scale 0-10) or higher in all courses that are transferred</p> <p>It is possible to transfer up to 50%, if a previous study (program) is continuous and completely comparable study according to the School's Curriculum Council. If the above is not relevant, max number of transfer credits is 45 ECTS but 60 ECTS if credits come from a second major.</p> <p>When evaluating credits from a completed degree the following rule will apply:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The grade must be 6 (on the scale 0-10) or higher in all courses that are transferred. 2. A student must finish at least 60 ECTS in his/her degree at RU. If a degree involves a final project or a thesis, the student needs to write a new final project / thesis at RU. 3. A student must spend at least 50% of his/her study time at RU. Students need to apply for credit evaluation from previous studies using special forms and submit formal confirmations of previous studies. The relevant School's Curriculum Council is responsible for the evaluation of previous studies. 	Students can take each course two times and take the exams offered each time. To take a course means to have been registered in the course after the deadline for recession has passed.	Generally the grade of 5 is the minimum grade for passing a course.

Students can apply for exceptions from these rules to the relevant School's Curriculum Council.
